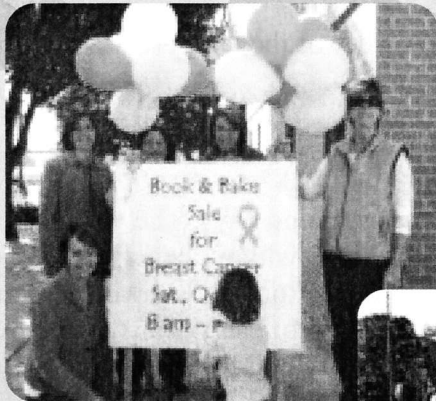


National Radiologic Technology Week®
